KESWICK ADAMS

There is a new country artist on the B.C. music scene. We are happy to introduce y'all to Keswick Adams (or as friends like to call him, Kez). Kez has just finished his debut album, "Free Country" and he has made sure that every part of the project was Canadian made. He has used his experience as a producer to put together a new spin on the country sound, using some non-traditional methods and production styles to create something new. He is a storyteller and much of his stories have been inspired from a west coast perspective.

It was in his late teens that Keswick Adams started saving his money and collecting recording gear as well as instruments to start crafting his music. He has also been very active in the open mic scene and booking his own shows for the better part of the decade. Ten years later and he is ready to market his music and now has a record to show for it. He used the Warehouse Studios in Vancouver to finalize his mixes and sent them off to Toronto to Joao Carvalho for mastering. His records are being printed in Surrey and his release date is scheduled for August 30th where he will be having a release party at the Yale Saloon in Vancouver.

Kez is also packing up the van and doing a cross Canada tour in partnership with M.A.D.D. (mothers against drunk driving) this fall. He will be raising money and awareness for the cause, as well as getting his music out into the country.
