It is with very heavy hearts that we tell you of the passing of past BCCMA President Diana Kelly. On March 26th, 2015, Diana gently left this world and her battle with cancer.

Diana was a huge influence to everyone in the country music industry. Diana loved country music, and everything associated with it. Her country music career lasted almost 40 years, including her 1999 induction into the BCCMA Hall of Fame. She excelled in artist management and sound and video production, and was the marketing queen for the Hedley Blast. Most importantly, for 17 years Diana spearheaded the Merritt Mountain Music Festival, a Western Canadian country music festival of unprecedented distinction.

Diana understood the value of establishing the roots of a music genre and tirelessly nurtured and developed new talent. Some very well known Canadian artists of today received great encouragement and support from Diana. Although small in size, Diana's larger than life persona and vibrant smile was well known. Everyone in the industry, from sponsors, record labels, stage hands, studio engineers and producers to musicians and songwriters, knew and respected this lady. She will be fondly remembered and dearly missed!

We wish her family and friends our condolences, and our thoughts and prayers are with them at this time. Keep smiling and dancing, Diana!
